The following is in response to your 3/3/2010 telephone request regarding Arizona Cattle Growers' request for an extension on our solicitation for jaguar information.

In our jaguar critical habitat prudency determination (75 FR 1741), we published an information submission date of March 15, 2010, to encourage the submission of information sufficiently early in our critical habitat deliberation.

Our information gathering will continue after March 15, 2010. However, to allow us adequate time to consider and incorporate submitted information into our review, we encourage you to submit your information as soon as possible.
