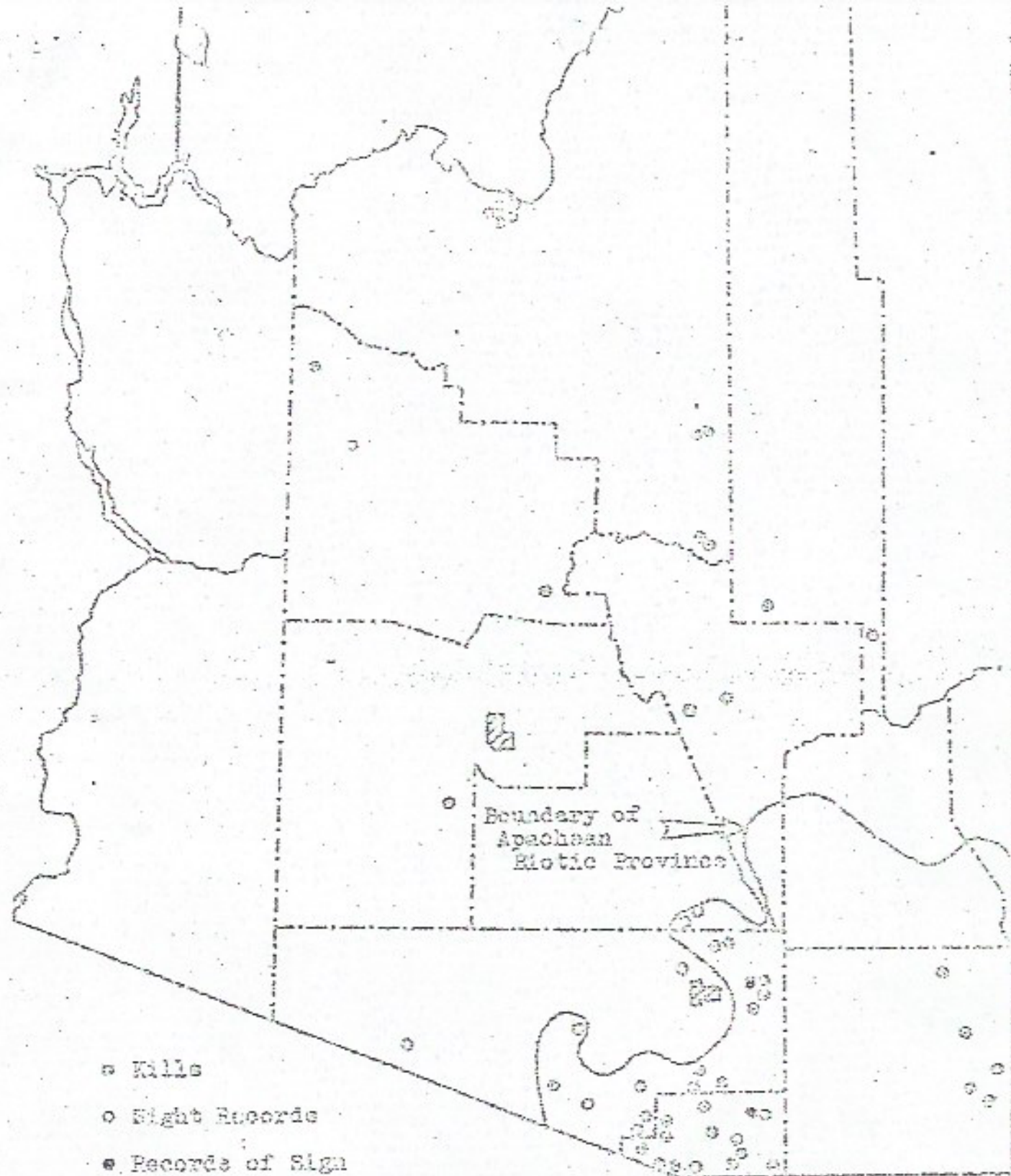


Fig. 1. Distribution of Jaguar Records in Arizona.
